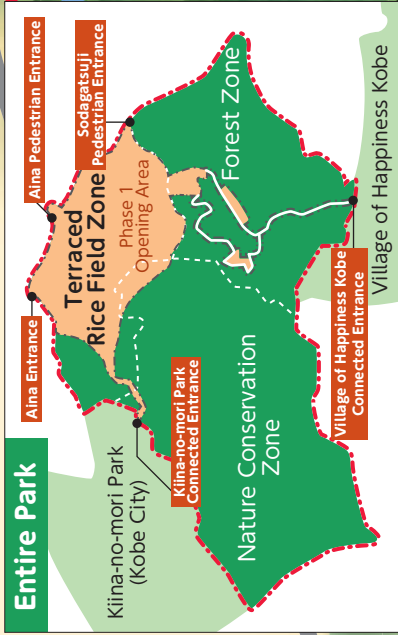
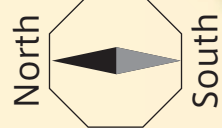

Kiina-no-mori Park Connected Entrance



1 Nagaya Gate



This is the park's general information center. It reproduces the outer gate of a nagaya, typically found in the estates of wealthy farming households, such as those of Village headmen.

2 Dengo House (Traditional House) and Farmhouse



Dengo House (Traditional House) is a relocated old thatched farmhouse, originally built in the early Edo period.

3 Satoyama Information House



The exhibit features live creatures, specimens, fossils, and mushrooms found in the park.

4 Farm Village Theatre



This is a recreation of a thatched rural stage from the Aina community. It hosts various events, including traditional performing arts.

5 Satoyama Community House and Woodworking Studio



The Satoyama Community House hosts environmental education programs, seminars, and exhibitions, while the Woodworking Studio offers crafts and other hands-on activities.

6 Shirabeshi House (Traditional House)



Shirabeshi is a place associated with the folklore of Minamoto no Yoshitsune. This relocated thatched house was originally a headman's residence, built at the end of the Edo period.

7 Sodagatsuji House (Traditional House)



Sodagatsuji is a place of folklore related to the Battle of Hinojani. It is an old thatched house that was moved from an inn built in the early Meiji period.

8 Medaka Pond (Japanese Rice Fish Pond)



Medaka Pond offers the opportunity to observe various water creatures, including Japanese rice fish. The Komi River flows immediately to the south of the pond.

9 Asobi-no-mori Park



This playground is set in a wooded area and features four large slides and other play equipment.
